

SENATE BILL No. 88

February 14, 1991, Introduced by Senators EHLERS and GAST
and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and
Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend section 315 of Act No. 86 of the Public Acts
of 1980, entitled
"The hunting and fishing license act,"
as amended by Act No. 63 of the Public Acts of 1986, being sec-
tion 316.315 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 315 of Act No. 86 of the Public Acts of
2 1980, as amended by Act No. 63 of the Public Acts of 1986, being
3 section 316.315 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 315. (1) A person 17 years of age or older shall not
6 fish in the waters over which this state has jurisdiction without
7 a license. The fee for a resident annual fishing license shall
8 be \$20.00. ~~\$7.00. Beginning on April 1, 1987, the fee for a~~
9 ~~resident annual fishing license shall be \$9.50. The fee for a~~

1 ~~nonresident annual fishing license shall be \$15.00. Beginning on~~
2 ~~April 1, 1986, a nonresident annual fishing license shall be~~
3 ~~\$20.00.~~

4 (2) The annual fishing license shall entitle the licensee to
5 take fish other than trout or salmon.

6 (3) The holder of an annual fishing license, upon payment of
7 an additional fee of ~~-\$7.00~~ \$9.50, may procure a trout and
8 salmon stamp which shall entitle the holder to take trout and
9 salmon in a manner and at a time prescribed by law. ~~Beginning~~
10 ~~on April 1, 1987, the fee for a trout and salmon stamp shall be~~
11 ~~\$9.50.~~

12 ~~(4) The holder of an annual fishing license who purchases a~~
13 ~~salmon snagging stamp under section 11 of chapter III of the~~
14 ~~Michigan sportsmen fishing law, Act No. 165 of the Public Acts of~~
15 ~~1929, being section 303.11 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is not~~
16 ~~required to purchase a trout and salmon stamp to snag salmon~~
17 ~~lawfully.~~

18 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
