

SENATE BILL No. 171

March 13, 1991, Introduced by Senator DE GROW and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Reapportionment.

A bill to divide this state into 18 congressional districts; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and officers; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This state is divided into 18 congressional dis-
2 tricts pursuant to the ratio of representation fixed under an act
3 of congress for the apportionment of the representatives among
4 the several states. Each district is entitled to 1
5 representative. The districts are constituted and numbered as
6 follows:

15 Sec. 2. The secretary of state shall prepare a map and a
16 legal description of each district constituted under this act.
17 The legal description shall be in terms of political subdivi-
18 sions, such as counties, cities, and townships; man-made fea-
19 tures, such as streets, roads, highways, and railroads; and natu-
20 ral features, such as waterways, which political subdivisions and
21 man-made and natural features form the boundaries of the
22 district. The secretary of state shall convey the map and legal
23 description of each district to the legislature and the
24 governor.

25 Sec. 3. As used in this act:

1 (a) "Block" means block as that term is used by the United
2 States department of commerce, bureau of the census in conducting
3 the 1990 decennial census.

4 (b) "ED" means enumeration district as that term is used by
5 the United States department of commerce, bureau of the census in
6 conducting the 1990 decennial census.

7 (c) "Tract" means tract as that term is used by the United
8 States department of commerce, bureau of the census in conducting
9 the 1990 decennial census.

10 Sec. 4. Act No. 282 of the Public Acts of 1964, being sec-
11 tions 3.51 to 3.52 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is repealed.
