

SENATE BILL No. 193

March 14, 1991, Introduced by Senator V. SMITH and
referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill to amend Act No. 198 of the Public Acts of 1974,
entitled

"An act to provide for the establishment of plant rehabilitation districts and industrial development districts in local governmental units; to provide for the exemption from certain taxes; to levy and collect a specific tax upon the owners of certain facilities; to provide for the disposition of the tax; to provide for the obtaining and transferring of an exemption certificate and to prescribe the contents of those certificates; to prescribe the powers and duties of the state tax commission and certain officers of local governmental units; and to provide penalties,"

as amended, being sections 207.551 to 207.571 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 22.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 198 of the Public Acts of 1974, as
2 amended, being sections 207.551 to 207.571 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 22 to read as
4 follows:

1 SEC. 22. A NEW EXEMPTION SHALL NOT BE GRANTED UNDER THIS
2 ACT AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION.

3 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
4 Senate Joint Resolution G
5 of the 86th Legislature becomes part of
6 the constitution as provided in section 1 of article XII of the
7 state constitution of 1963.
