## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as
- 2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3 Laws, is amended by adding section 490b to read as follows:
- 4 SEC. 490B. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT MALICIOUSLY THREATEN TO
- 5 KILL, OR INJURE THE HEALTH OF, THE GOVERNOR OF THIS STATE OR A
- 6 MEMBER OF THE SENATE OR HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THIS STATE.
- 7 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A
- 8 FELONY, PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS, OR
- 9 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000.00, OR BOTH.
