SENATE BILL No. 394

June 27, 1991, Introduced by Senator STABENOW and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend section 21 of chapter IV of Act No. 3 of the Public Acts of 1895, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the incorporation of villages; to define their powers and duties; to provide for the levy and collection of taxes, borrowing of money, and issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness by villages; to define the powers and duties of the municipal finance commission or its successor agency and of the department of treasury with regard thereto; to define the application of this act and provide for its amendment by villages subject thereto; and to validate prior amendments and certain prior actions taken and bonds issued by villages,"

being section 64.21 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 3 Laws, is amended to read as follows:

1 CHAPTER IV

Sec. 21. The president and -trustees shall each receive 3 such sum as shall be fixed by ordinance for each regular meeting 4 of the village council by them respectively attended during their 5 term of office, such payment to be made out of the general fund 6 in the village treasury. Said officers shall receive no other 7 compensation for services performed for and on behalf of said 8 village during their term of office: Provided, That in no case 9 shall such president or any trustee receive compensation for any 10 meetings not actually attended. All other officers except where 11 other provision is made herein EACH TRUSTEE SHALL RECEIVE COM-12 PENSATION FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE OF 13 PRESIDENT OR TRUSTEE AS PROVIDED BY ORDINANCE. THE ORDINANCE 14 SHALL SPECIFY THE MANNER AND METHOD THAT THE COMPENSATION IS DUE 15 AND PAYABLE. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS ACT or by OTHER 16 law regulating fees for services, OTHER OFFICERS shall receive 17 such compensation as MAY BE PRESCRIBED BY the council. - shall 18 prescribe.
