A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4088 AS INTRODUCED 2-2-93

The bill would allow the Department of Natural Resources to convey certain state-owned property (the Rochester-Utica Recreation Area), located in Macomb and Oakland counties, to a number of local governments. Each conveyance would be for one dollar and the land would have to be used for a public park. If it were used for any other purpose it would immediately revert to the state. The state would retain oil, coal, gas, and other materials (except for sand, gravel, clay, and other nonmetallic minerals).

The Rochester-Utica Recreation Area lies within the boundaries of four municipalities in Macomb and Oakland Counties: The charter township of Shelby (in Macomb County), the city of Utica (in Macomb County), and the cities of Rochester and Rochester Hills (both in Oakland County). The bill would convey to each of these municipalities the state-owned parts of the Rochester-Utica Recreation Area lying within their respective boundaries.
