A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4326 AS INTRODUCED 2-23-93

The bill would amend the lobbyist registration act to prohibit a person who resigns a state elective office from registering as a lobbyist or lobbyist agent for the remainder of the term of office from which he or she resigned. The term "state elective office" would be adopted from the Michigan Campaign Finance Act to refer to the offices of governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, attorney general, supreme court justice, member of the state board of education, regent of the University of Michigan, trustee of Michigan State University, governor of Wayne State University, and member of the state legislature.
