A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4358 AS INTRODUCED 2-24-93

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to generally require prosecutors to prosecute criminal contempt proceedings initiated for violation of domestic violence injunctions and injunctions prohibiting removing children from those who have legal custody, or prohibiting entering onto premises. The requirement would not apply if the person who procured the injunction retained his or her own attorney for the proceeding.

The court would have to notify the prosecutor of the criminal contempt proceeding, and also notify any attorney of record for the person who had procured the injunction.
