A REVISED SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4444 AS INTRODUCED 3-4-93

Public Act 164 of 1877, the Municipal Library Act, permits a city, village, or township to levy up to one mill for a library fund. The millage may be increased to a maximum of two mills if approved by the voters at a regular annual election. House Bill 4444 would amend the act to provide, in addition, that a previously authorized millage that had been approved for a specific number of years could be renewed if approved by the voters in this manner.
