A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4522 AS INTRODUCED 3-23-93

Public Act 87 of 1986 created the so-called "lemon law," which requires the manufacturer of a defective vehicle to either replace a vehicle or refund its full purchase price if the manufacturer fails in a reasonable number of attempts to repair the defect, under certain conditions. The 1986 law specifically exempted leased vehicles from its provisions. House Bill 4522 would extend the provisions of the lemon law to cover leased vehicles.
