A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4615 AS INTRODUCED 4-20-93

The bill would amend the child care licensing act to require child care institutions, child care centers, foster homes, and day care homes to have someone on duty who had satisfactorily completed training and certification in basic first aid and infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) offered by the American Red Cross or a comparable organization or institution approved by the Department of Social Services.
