House Bill 4858 as introduced

First Analysis (9-22-93)

PROBATE CODE TECH. AMEND.

Sponsor: Rep. David M. Gubow Committee: Judiciary

THE APPARENT PROBLEM:

Under at least one proposed version of House Bill 4064, the "third-party custody bill" that is at present in conference committee, the Child Custody Act would be amended such that a reference to it in the probate code would be rendered incorrect. In anticipation of the conference report on House Bill 4064, it has been suggested that legislation be drafted to correct the applicable reference in the probate code.

THE CONTENT OF THE BILL:

The bill would amend the Revised Probate Code to change a reference to Section 6b (4) of the Child Custody Act to refer to Section 6f. (At least one version proposed for House Bill 4064 would repeal Section 6b and replace it with a newly-created Section 6f.) The bill could not take effect unless House Bill 4064 was enacted.
