

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4016**

February 2, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Keith and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend section 1249 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended "The school code of 1976," as added by Act No. 232 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 380.1249 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1249 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1976, as added by Act No. 232 of the Public Acts of 1988,
- 3 being section 380.1249 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1249. (1) The board of a school district or intermedi-
- 6 ate school district shall provide that each secondary school
- 7 teacher in the district may review a copy of the official
- 8 transcript of each pupil the teacher taught.

- 1 (2) The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE board of a 2 school district or intermediate school district shall not permit 3 any board member, superintendent, assistant superintendent, prin-4 cipal, assistant principal, guidance director, teacher, or any 5 other person to change a grade given to a pupil by a teacher 6 unless to f the following occurs: (a) The THE teacher who gave 7 THE grade to the pupil is informed of 1 or more reasons why 8 the grade should be changed and the teacher concurs in the grade
- (b) If a teacher who gave a grade to the pupil does not concur in the grade change, a majority of a review panel, after evaluating the reasons for a requested grade change, approves the grade change and the teacher involved does not appeal the panel's decision. The panel described in this subdivision shall be composed of 3 teachers selected by their bargaining unit, 1 board member, and the superintendent of schools or the superintendent's designee.
- (c) If the teacher involved appeals the decision of the review panel described in subdivision (b) to the board, and a majority of the board members elected and serving approve the grade change at a meeting of the board at which the reasons for changing the grade are reviewed. A decision of the board on the merits of the grade change shall be final.
- 24 (3) IF THE TEACHER WHO GAVE THE GRADE DOES NOT CONCUR IN A
  25 GRADE CHANGE PROPOSED UNDER SUBSECTION (2), A TEACHER, A COUNSEL26 OR, OR, SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (4), THE PRINCIPAL OF THE SCHOOL,
  27 AFTER CONSULTING WITH THE TEACHER WHO GAVE THE GRADE AND THE

- 1 PROPONENT OF THE GRADE CHANGE, MAY CAUSE A REVIEW PANEL DESCRIBED
- 2 IN SUBSECTION (5) TO CONVENE TO CONSIDER A GRADE CHANGE. A
- 3 PERSON CAUSING A REVIEW PANEL TO CONVENE SHALL FILE A NOTICE TO
- 4 THAT EFFECT WITH THE BOARD, AND THE REVIEW PANEL SHALL MEET TO
- 5 CONSIDER THE PROPOSED GRADE CHANGE WITHIN 20 DAYS AFTER THE
- 6 NOTICE IS FILED WITH THE BOARD. AFTER EVALUATING THE REASONS FOR
- 7 THE PROPOSED GRADE CHANGE, THE REVIEW PANEL, BY A MAJORITY OF ITS
- 8 MEMBERS, MAY APPROVE, DISAPPROVE, OR MODIFY THE PROPOSED GRADE
- 9 CHANGE. THE REVIEW PANEL SHALL NOT APPROVE A PROPOSED GRADE
- 10 CHANGE, OR APPROVE A PROPOSED GRADE CHANGE AS MODIFIED BY THE
- 11 REVIEW PANEL, UNLESS THE REVIEW PANEL FINDS THAT THE PROPONENT OF
- 12 THE GRADE CHANGE HAS MET THE BURDEN OF ESTABLISHING THAT THERE
- 13 WAS NO RATIONAL BASIS FOR THE CHALLENGED GRADE UNDER THE
- 14 TEACHER'S ESTABLISHED GRADING PROCEDURES.
- 15 (4) A PRINCIPAL SHALL NOT CAUSE A REVIEW PANEL TO CONVENE
- 16 UNLESS THE PROPONENT OF THE GRADE CHANGE SUBMITS A REQUEST FOR
- 17 THE GRADE CHANGE TO THE PRINCIPAL IN WRITING SETTING FORTH THE
- 18 REASONS FOR THE GRADE CHANGE WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE PUPIL
- 19 RECEIVED THE GRADE. IF THE PRINCIPAL DECIDES TO CAUSE THE REVIEW
- 20 PANEL TO CONVENE, HE OR SHE SHALL DO SO NOT LATER THAN 30 DAYS
- 21 AFTER HE OR SHE RECEIVES THE WRITTEN REQUEST FOR THE PROPOSED
- 22 GRADE CHANGE.
- 23 (5) A REVIEW PANEL CONSIDERING A GRADE CHANGE UNDER THIS
- 24 SECTION SHALL BE COMPOSED OF 3 TEACHERS SELECTED BY THEIR BAR-
- 25 GAINING UNIT, 1 BOARD MEMBER SELECTED BY THE BOARD, AND THE DIS-
- 26 TRICT SUPERINTENDENT OR THE SUPERINTENDENT'S DESIGNEE. IF A
- 27 MEMBER OF THE REVIEW PANEL IS INVOLVED IN A PROPOSED GRADE

- 1 CHANGE, THAT MEMBER SHALL BE REPLACED ON THE REVIEW PANEL BY AN
- 2 ALTERNATE FOR CONSIDERING THAT PROPOSED GRADE CHANGE. THE PERSON
- 3 WHO CAUSES THE REVIEW PANEL TO CONVENE SHALL NOT SERVE AS A
- 4 MEMBER OF THE REVIEW PANEL.
- 5 (6) THE TEACHER WHO GAVE THE GRADE OR THE PROPONENT OF THE
- 6 GRADE CHANGE MAY APPEAL THE DECISION OF THE REVIEW PANEL TO THE
- 7 BOARD NOT LATER THAN 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE DECISION. THE
- 8 BOARD SHALL CONSIDER THE APPEAL AT A MEETING OF THE BOARD AT
- 9 WHICH THE REASONS FOR AND AGAINST THE PROPOSED GRADE CHANGE ARE
- 10 REVIEWED. THE BOARD, BY A MAJORITY OF THE BOARD MEMBERS ELECTED
- 11 AND SERVING, MAY APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE THE DECISION OF THE REVIEW
- 12 PANEL. THE DECISION OF THE BOARD ON WHETHER OR NOT THE GRADE IS
- 13 TO BE CHANGED IS FINAL.
- 14 (7) IF THERE IS NO TIMELY APPEAL UNDER SUBSECTION (6), THE
- 15 DECISION OF THE REVIEW PANEL IS FINAL.
- 16 (8) -(3) A pupil THE PUPIL AND THE PUPIL'S PARENT OR GUARD-
- 17 IAN AND THE TEACHER WHO GAVE THE GRADE shall be informed of a
- 18 DECISION ON A PROPOSED grade change made pursuant to this
- 19 section.
- 20 (9) (4) A board review of a grade change provided for in
- 21 -subsection (2)(c) THIS SECTION shall comply with section 438 of
- 22 subpart 2 of part c of the general education provisions act,
- 23 title IV of Public Law 90-247, 20 U.S.C. 1232g, commonly referred
- 24 to as the family educational rights and privacy act of 1974.
- 25 (10) -(5) The board of a school district or intermediate
- 26 school district shall establish AND ENFORCE a disciplinary
- 27 procedure -which shall be enforced when TO BE INVOKED IF a

- 1 person violates the grade changing procedure described in this
  2 section.
- 3 (11) IF A PUPIL'S GRADE IS CHANGED BY A REVIEW PANEL UNDER
- 4 THIS SECTION, A NOTATION SHALL BE MADE IN THE PUPIL'S RECORD THAT
- 5 THE GRADE CHANGE WAS MADE BY A REVIEW PANEL.
- 6 (12) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PREVENT A SCHOOL DISTRICT FROM
- 7 ADOPTING OR MAINTAINING A LOCAL POLICY OR PROCEDURE THAT PERMITS
- 8 THE PUPIL REQUESTING A GRADE CHANGE OR THE PUPIL'S PARENT OR
- 9 LEGAL GUARDIAN TO ATTEND A REVIEW PANEL MEETING CONVENED FOR CON-
- 10 SIDERING THE PROPOSED GRADE CHANGE OR TO MAKE AN ORAL OR WRITTEN
- 11 PRESENTATION TO THE REVIEW PANEL.
- 12 (13) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "GRADE" MEANS A GRADE GIVEN
- 13 FOR A FINAL EXAMINATION OR A GRADE GIVEN AT THE CONCLUSION OF A
- 14 MARKING PERIOD, SEMESTER, OR TERM.
