



HOUSE BILL No. 4114

February 2, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Dalman, Nye, Rhead, Gernaat, McNutt, Stille, McBryde, Jaye, Llewellyn, London, Galloway, McManus, Bodem, Horton, Shugars, Rivers, Vorva, Banks, Freeman, Brown, Dolan, Pitoniak, Bullard and Gire and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 411 of the Public Acts of 1988, entitled
"Recycling makes cents, office paper recovery act,"
being section 299.462 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 411 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 299.462 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2. As used in this act:

(a) "Department" means the department of natural resources.

(b) "Recycled paper" and "recycled wastepaper" means a paper product that contains not less than 50% wastepaper.

(c) "Wastepaper" means any discarded paper OR CARDBOARD that is generated after the completion of the paper manufacturing process, and includes but is not limited to trimmings, printed

- 1 paper, cutting and converting paper, NEWSPRINT, TELEPHONE BOOKS,
- 2 CATALOGS, or ~~post-consumer~~ OTHER POSTCONSUMER paper.
- 3 Wastepaper ~~shall~~ DOES not include mill broke or other in-plant
- 4 residual wastes.
