A bill to provide for the biennial audit of the legislative branch by the auditor general.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. (1) The auditor general shall biennially audit the
- 2 financial transactions and accounts of the legislative branch,
- 3 including, but not limited to, both house of the legislature and
- 4 all legislative agencies, commissions, and councils.
- 5 (2) The completed audit shall be submitted to the governor
- 6 and each house of the legislature.
