

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4363**

February 24, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Pitoniak, Scott, Freeman, Jamian, Vorva, Dolan, Hammerstrom, Llewellyn, Points, DeMars and Ciaramitaro and referred to the Committee on Consumers.

A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled as amended

"The Michigan penal code,"

as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 95b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as
- 2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3 Laws, is amended by adding section 95b to read as follows:
- 4 SEC. 95B. (1) A MERCHANT SHALL NOT REQUIRE, AS A CONDITION
- 5 OF ACCEPTANCE OF A CHECK, DRAFT, WARRANT, OR OTHER INSTRUMENT
- 6 THAT AUTHORIZES THE PAYMENT OF MONEY, THAT A CREDIT CARD OR
- 7 SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER BE WRITTEN ON THE CHECK, DRAFT, WARRANT,
- 8 OR OTHER INSTRUMENT.
