



HOUSE BILL No. 4367

February 24, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Bryant, Sikkema, Jaye and London and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of 1979, entitled as amended

"The state school aid act of 1979,"

as amended, being sections 388.1601 to 388.1772 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 148.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of 1979, as
2 amended, being sections 388.1601 to 388.1772 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 148 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 148. BEGINNING JULY 1, 1993, IF A DISTRICT THAT
6 RECEIVES UNENCUMBERED STATE SCHOOL AID UNDER THIS ACT HOLDS MORE
7 THAN 180 DAYS OF PUPIL INSTRUCTION IN A SCHOOL YEAR, THE AMOUNT
8 OF THAT UNENCUMBERED STATE SCHOOL AID ALLOCATED TO THE DISTRICT
9 SHALL BE INCREASED BY 1/180 FOR EACH DAY OF PUPIL INSTRUCTION IN

1 EXCESS OF 180 AND UP TO A MAXIMUM OF 210. THE INCREASED PAYMENT
2 SHALL BE MADE IN THE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR IN THE
3 FIRST PAYMENT OF STATE SCHOOL AID. AS USED IN THIS SECTION,
4 "UNENCUMBERED STATE SCHOOL AID" MEANS FORMULA AID UNDER SECTION
5 21(1) OR CATEGORICAL AID THAT IS NOT FIXED BY CONTRACTUAL
6 ARRANGEMENT OR A SPECIFIC PROJECT GRANT.
