

HOUSE BILL No. 4474

March 10, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Bankes, Middleton, Dolan, Gilmer, Bender, Johnson and Stille and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of public health for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the state agency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHICAN ENACT:

1	Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of public health
2	for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, from the following funds:

2	Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
3	article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from
4	state resources in this appropriations act for the fiscal year ending
5	September 30, 1994 is \$ and state appropriations paid to
6	units of local government are 0.
7	Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under
8	this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices, and programs
9	for which appropriations are made under this act are subject to Act
0	No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of
1	the Michigan Compiled Laws.
