



HOUSE BILL No. 4753

May 11, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Scott, Joe Young, Jr., Dolan, Gubow, Gire, Points and Jondahl and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend Act No. 319 of the Public Acts of 1990,
entitled

"An act to prohibit local units of government from imposing certain restrictions on the ownership, registration, purchase, sale, transfer, transportation, or possession of pistols or other firearms, ammunition for pistols or other firearms, or components of pistols or other firearms,"

being sections 123.1101 to 123.1105 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 4a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 319 of the Public Acts of 1990, being
2 sections 123.1101 to 123.1105 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended by adding section 4a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 4A. (1) THIS ACT DOES NOT PROHIBIT A LOCAL UNIT OF
5 GOVERNMENT FROM REGULATING THE STORAGE OF FIREARMS, AMMUNITION,
6 OR DESTRUCTIVE DEVICES BY A DEALER AT A SPECIFIED LOCATION IF ALL
7 OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST:

1 (A) THE LOCATION IS AN ESTABLISHED PLACE OF BUSINESS THAT IS
2 REGULARLY OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

3 (B) THE DEALER CONDUCTS ANY TYPE OF BUSINESS AS A DEALER AT
4 THE LOCATION.

5 (C) THE DEALER HAS POSSESSION OF 10 OR MORE FIREARMS OR
6 DESTRUCTIVE DEVICES, IN ANY COMBINATION, AT THE LOCATION AT ANY
7 GIVEN TIME DURING A CALENDAR YEAR.

8 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "AMMUNITION", "DEALER", AND
9 "DESTRUCTIVE DEVICE" MEAN THOSE TERMS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 921
10 OF CHAPTER 44 OF TITLE 18 OF THE UNITED STATES CODE, 18
11 U.S.C. 921.
