

HOUSE BILL No. 4945

A bill to repeal Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of 1967, entitled

"Optional retirement act of 1967,"

being sections 38.381 to 38.388 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, on a specific date.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of 1967, being
- 2 sections 38.381 to 38.388 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 repealed effective January 1, 1994.
- Section 2. This act shall not take effect unless Senate
