

HOUSE BILL No. 4960

July 15, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Baade and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended
"Public health code,"
as amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding sections 16433, 17089, 17243, 17434, 17557, 17771, 17823, 18034, 18118, 18238, 18312, 18423, 18836, and 20180.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as
- 2 amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding sections 16433, 17089, 17243,
- 4 17434, 17557, 17771, 17823, 18034, 18118, 18238, 18312, 18423,
- 5 18836, and 20180 to read as follows:
- 6 SEC. 16433. (1) A DOCTOR OF CHIROPRACTIC SHALL NOT
- 7 REPRESENT HIMSELF OR HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE

- 1 TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED
- 2 UNDER THIS ARTICLE UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER
- 3 THIS ARTICLE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH
- 4 PROFESSION.
- 5 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF CHIROPRACTIC, A DOCTOR
- 6 OF CHIROPRACTIC SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION, OR PRO-
- 7 CEDURE THAT IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE.
- 8 SEC. 17089. (1) A PHYSICIAN SHALL NOT REPRESENT HIMSELF OR
- 9 HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRAC-
- 10 TICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 11 UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO
- 12 ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH PROFESSION.
- 13 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE, A PHYSICIAN
- 14 SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION, OR PROCEDURE THAT IS
- 15 OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE.
- 16 SEC. 17243. (1) A REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL NURSE SHALL NOT
- 17 REPRESENT HIMSELF OR HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE
- 18 TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED
- 19 UNDER THIS ARTICLE UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER
- 20 THIS ARTICLE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH
- 21 PROFESSION.
- 22 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF NURSING, A REGISTERED
- 23 PROFESSIONAL NURSE SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION, OR
- 24 PROCEDURE THAT IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE.
- 25 SEC. 17434. (1) AN OPTOMETRIST SHALL NOT REPRESENT HIMSELF
- 26 OR HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE
- 27 PRACTICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE

- 1 UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO
- 2 ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH PROFESSION.
- 3 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF OPTOMETRY, AN OPTOME-
- 4 TRIST SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION, OR PROCEDURE THAT
- 5 IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE.
- 6 SEC. 17557. (1) A PHYSICIAN SHALL NOT REPRESENT HIMSELF OR
- 7 HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRAC-
- 8 TICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 9 UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO
- 10 ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH PROFESSION.
- 11 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE
- 12 AND SURGERY, A PHYSICIAN SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNC-
- 13 TION, OR PROCEDURE THAT IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER
- 14 LICENSE.
- 15 SEC. 17771. (1) A PHARMACIST SHALL NOT REPRESENT HIMSELF OR
- 16 HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRAC-
- 17 TICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 18 UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO
- 19 ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH PROFESSION.
- 20 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF PHARMACY, A PHARMACIST
- 21 SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION, OR PROCEDURE THAT IS
- 22 OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE.
- 23 SEC. 17823. (1) A PHYSICAL THERAPIST SHALL NOT REPRESENT
- 24 HIMSELF OR HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE TO ENGAGE
- 25 IN THE PRACTICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED UNDER THIS
- 26 ARTICLE UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 27 TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH PROFESSION.

- 1 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF PHYSICAL THERAPY, A
- 2 PHYSICAL THERAPIST SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION, OR
- 3 PROCEDURE THAT IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE.
- 4 SEC. 18034. (1) A PODIATRIST SHALL NOT REPRESENT HIMSELF OR
- 5 HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRAC-
- 6 TICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 7 UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO
- 8 ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH PROFESSION.
- 9 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF PODIATRIC MEDICINE AND
- 10 SURGERY, A PODIATRIST SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION,
- 11 OR PROCEDURE THAT IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE.
- 12 SEC. 18118. (1) A LICENSED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR SHALL NOT
- 13 REPRESENT HIMSELF OR HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE
- 14 TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED
- 15 UNDER THIS ARTICLE UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER
- 16 THIS ARTICLE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH
- 17 PROFESSION.
- 18 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF COUNSELING, A LICENSED
- 19 PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION,
- 20 OR PROCEDURE THAT IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE.
- 21 SEC. 18238. (1) A PSYCHOLOGIST SHALL NOT REPRESENT HIMSELF
- 22 OR HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE
- 23 PRACTICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 24 UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO
- 25 ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH PROFESSION.

- 1 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOLOGY, A
- 2 PSYCHOLOGIST SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION, OR
- 3 PROCEDURE THAT IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE.
- 4 SEC. 18312. (1) A CERTIFIED OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST SHALL
- 5 NOT REPRESENT HIMSELF OR HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A
- 6 LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF A HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED
- 7 UNDER THIS ARTICLE UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER
- 8 THIS ARTICLE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH
- 9 PROFESSION.
- 10 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF HIS OR HER HEALTH PRO-
- 11 FESSION, A CERTIFIED OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST SHALL NOT PERFORM AN
- 12 ACT, TASK, FUNCTION, OR PROCEDURE THAT IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF
- 13 THE DEFINITION OF CERTIFIED OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST.
- 14 SEC. 18423. (1) A SANITARIAN SHALL NOT REPRESENT HIMSELF OR
- 15 HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRAC-
- 16 TICE OF A HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE UNLESS HE
- 17 OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO ENGAGE IN THE
- 18 PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH PROFESSION.
- 19 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF HIS OR HER HEALTH PRO-
- 20 FESSION, A SANITARIAN SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION,
- 21 OR PROCEDURE THAT IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF THE DEFINITION OF
- 22 SANITARIAN.
- SEC. 18836. (1) A VETERINARIAN SHALL NOT REPRESENT HIMSELF
- 24 OR HERSELF TO THE PUBLIC AS HOLDING A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE
- 25 PRACTICE OF ANOTHER HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE
- 26 UNLESS HE OR SHE HOLDS A VALID LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO
- 27 ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF THAT HEALTH PROFESSION.

- 1 (2) WHILE ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF VETERINARY MEDICINE, A
- 2 VETERINARIAN SHALL NOT PERFORM AN ACT, TASK, FUNCTION, OR PROCE-
- 3 DURE THAT IS OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE.
- 4 SEC. 20180. A PERSON EMPLOYED BY OR UNDER CONTRACT TO A
- 5 HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY OR ANY OTHER PERSON ACTING IN GOOD
- 6 FAITH WHO MAKES A REPORT INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A REPORT
- 7 OF A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE OR A RULE PROMULGATED UNDER THIS
- 8 ARTICLE; WHO ASSISTS IN ORIGINATING, INVESTIGATING, OR PREPARING
- 9 A REPORT; OR WHO ASSISTS THE DEPARTMENT IN CARRYING OUT ITS
- 10 DUTIES UNDER THIS ARTICLE IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL OR CRIMINAL
- 11 LIABILITY THAT MIGHT OTHERWISE BE INCURRED THEREBY AND IS PRO-
- 12 TECTED UNDER THE WHISTLEBLOWERS' PROTECTION ACT, ACT NO. 469 OF
- 13 THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1980, BEING SECTIONS 15.361 TO 15.369 OF THE
- 14 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS. A PERSON DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION WHO
- 15 MAKES OR ASSISTS IN MAKING A REPORT, OR WHO ASSISTS THE DEPART-
- 16 MENT AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION, IS PRESUMED TO HAVE ACTED IN
- 17 GOOD FAITH. THE IMMUNITY FROM CIVIL OR CRIMINAL LIABILITY
- 18 GRANTED UNDER THIS SECTION EXTENDS ONLY TO ACTS DONE PURSUANT TO
- 19 THIS ARTICLE. THE IDENTITY OF A PERSON MAKING A REPORT AS
- 20 DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION IS CONFIDENTIAL AND SHALL NOT BE DIS-
- 21 CLOSED BY THE DEPARTMENT WITHOUT THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THAT
- 22 PERSON.
