

HOUSE BILL No. 4966

July 21, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Brackenridge, Wetters, DeMars and Dobronski and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 174 of the Public Acts of 1943, entitled

"An act to establish a fiscal year for and the time of filing annual reports based thereon of counties, county road commissions and other county agencies; and to declare the effect of this act,"

as amended by Act No. 83 of the Public Acts of 1983, being section 45.201 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 3.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 174 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1943, as amended by Act No. 83 of the Public Acts of 1983, being
- 3 section 45.201 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended and sec-
- 4 tion 3 is added to read as follows:
- Sec. 1. (1) Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the
- 6 contrary, AND EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), the fiscal

- 1 year for accounting purposes for each of the several counties of
- 2 this state, except counties having a population of 1,500,000 or
- 3 more, and for all county agencies, other than county road commis-
- 4 sions, of all counties, except counties having a population of
- 5 +,500,000 or more, A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF LESS THAN
- 6 1,500,000 shall be the calendar year ending December 31, of each
- 7 year, and all annual reports of such counties and county
- 8 agencies, THE COUNTY REQUIRED BY LAW AND based in whole or -in-
- 9 part on accounting completed within the fiscal year -, and
- 10 required by law, shall be filed within 30 days after the April
- 11 meeting of the county board of commissioners.
- 12 (2) IF SO DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, A
- 13 COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF LESS THAN 1,000,000 SHALL HAVE A
- 14 FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1 AND ENDING ON THE SUCCEEDING
- 15 SEPTEMBER 30. IF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDS ON SEPTEMBER 30, ANNUAL
- 16 REPORTS OF THE COUNTY REQUIRED BY LAW AND BASED IN WHOLE OR PART
- 17 ON ACCOUNTING COMPLETED WITHIN THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL BE FILED
- 18 BEFORE THE FOLLOWING MARCH 1.
- 19 (3) $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$ The county road commission of a county having a
- 20 population of less than 1,500,000 shall have the same fiscal year
- 21 as the other county agencies of that county unless, IN A
- 22 COUNTY HAVING A FISCAL YEAR ENDING ON DECEMBER 31, the county
- 23 road commission determines that its fiscal year shall begin on
- 24 October 1 and end on the succeeding September 30. The annual
- 25 report of a county road commission shall be made within 5 months
- 26 after the end of the fiscal year of the county road commission.

- 1 SEC. 3. AS USED IN THIS ACT, "COUNTY" MEANS A COUNTY OR A
- 2 COUNTY AGENCY IN THAT COUNTY, OTHER THAN THE COUNTY ROAD
- 3 COMMISSION.
