

HOUSE BILL No. 5033

September 21, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Profit and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to amend section 46 of Act No. 1 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1936, entitled as amended "Michigan employment security act," as amended by Act No. 164 of the Public Acts of 1983, being section 421.46 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 46 of Act No. 1 of the Public Acts of
- 2 the Extra Session of 1936, as amended by Act No. 164 of the
- 3 Public Acts of 1983, being section 421.46 of the Michigan
- 4 Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 46. (a) "Benefit year" with respect to any individual
- 6 means the period of 52 consecutive calendar weeks beginning with
- 7 the first calendar week with respect to which the individual, who
- 8 does not already have a benefit year in effect, files an
- 9 application in accordance with section 32. However, a benefit

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- I year shall not be established unless the individual meets all of
- 2 the following conditions:
- 3 (1) THE INDIVIDUAL has earned 20 credit weeks in the 52 con-
- 4 secutive calendar weeks IMMEDIATELY preceding the week with
- 5 respect to which the individual filed an application for
- 6 benefits. -;
- 7 (2) with WITH respect to the week for which the individual
- 8 is filing an application for benefits, THE INDIVIDUAL is unem-
- 9 ployed and meets all of the other requirements of section 28.
- 10 ---
- 11 (3) with WITH respect to the week for which the individual
- 12 is filing an application for benefits, the individual is not dis-
- 13 qualified nor subject to disqualification, except in case of a
- 14 labor dispute under section 29(8), with respect to the most
- 15 recent period of employment with the most recent employer with
- 16 whom the individual earned a credit week.
- If an individual files an application for a 7-day period as
- 18 provided in section 27(c), the benefit year with respect to the
- 19 individual shall begin BEGINS with the calendar week which
- 20 THAT contains the first day of that 7-day period.
- (b) If all, or the then remaining part, of a claimant's
- 22 rights to benefits during his or her benefit year are canceled
- 23 under the provisions of section 62(b), the remaining portion of
- 24 that benefit year shall be terminated as of ON the effective
- 25 date of the cancellation.
- 26 (c) An individual may request a redetermination of his or
- 27 her benefit rights and cancellation of a previously established

- 1 benefit year if he or she has not completed a compensable period.
- 2 -, in such IN THAT case, the benefit year -shall begin BEGINS
- 3 with the first day of the first week with respect to which the
- 4 request for redetermination of benefit rights is -duly filed.
- 5 (d) Notwithstanding section 43(g) and subsection (a), for
- 6 services performed on or after January 2, 1983, an individual
- 7 shall IS not -be- entitled to establish a benefit year based in
- 8 whole or in part on credit weeks for service in the employ of an
- 9 employing unit in which more than 50% of the proprietary interest
- 10 is owned by the individual or his or her son, daughter, or
- 11 spouse, or any combination of these individuals, or in which more
- 12 than 50% of the proprietary interest is owned by the mother or
- 13 father of a child under the age of 18, or mother and father com-
- 14 bined, unless both the individual and the employer notify the
- 15 commission, in response to the commission's request for informa-
- 16 tion, of the individual's relationship to the owners of the pro-
- 17 prietary interest in the employing unit. Upon timely notifica-
- 18 tion to the commission, a benefit year may be established for the
- 19 individual if the individual meets all of the following
- 20 conditions:
- 21 (1) THE INDIVIDUAL has earned 20 -credits CREDIT weeks in
- 22 the 52 consecutive calendar weeks IMMEDIATELY preceding the week
- 23 with respect to which the individual filed an application for
- 24 benefits. --
- 25 (2) -with- WITH respect to the week for which the individual
- 26 is filing an application for benefits, THE INDIVIDUAL is

- 1 unemployed and meets all of the other requirements of
- 2 section 28. -
- 3 (3) with WITH respect to the week for which the individual
- 4 is filing an application for benefits, the individual is not dis-
- 5 qualified nor subject to disqualification, except in case of a
- 6 labor dispute under section 29(8), with respect to the most
- 7 recent period of employment with the most recent employer with
- 8 whom the individual earned a credit week.
- 9 If an individual files an application for a 7-day period as
- 10 provided in section 27(c), the benefit year with respect to the
- 11 individual -shall begin BEGINS with the calendar week -which-
- 12 THAT contains the first day of that 7-day period. However, for
- 13 benefit years established on or after July 1, 1983, not more than
- 14 +0 credit weeks based on such services shall be used to pay
- 15 benefits. For the purpose of calculating the individual's aver-
- 16 age weekly wage, all base period wages and credit weeks shall be
- 17 used.
