



HOUSE BILL No. 5068

September 29, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Rhead, Hammerstrom, McNutt, Llewellyn and DeMars and referred to the Committee on Tourism and Recreation.

A bill to repeal Act No. 7 of the Local Acts of 1927, entitled

"An act to provide for the preservation of game by prohibiting hunting on Sunday in the county of Lapeer, to authorize the arrest of persons so offending and to prescribe the penalty therefor,"

and to authorize a referendum.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 7 of the Local Acts of 1927 is

2 repealed.

3 Section 2. (1) This act shall not take effect unless it is

4 submitted within 2 years of the enactment of this act to a vote

5 of the qualified electors of the county of Lapeer and ratified by

6 a majority of the electors voting on the question. The question

7 of the adoption of this act shall be submitted to the voters of

8 the county at the next general election, or any special election

1 called by the county board of commissioners after the enactment
2 of this act, and notice of this ballot question shall be given as
3 is required by law in the case of elections to elect county offi-
4 cers, and shall be submitted in substantially the following
5 form:

6 Shall Act No. _____ of the Local Acts of 1993, entitled "An
7 act to repeal Act No. 7 of the Local Acts of 1927, which is an
8 act passed in 1927 to prohibit hunting with firearms, dogs, or
9 otherwise in Lapeer county on Sunday," be adopted?

12 (2) The results of the vote shall be canvassed by the Lapeer
13 county board of canvassers.

14 (3) If a majority of the qualified electors voting on the
15 question, as determined by the canvass of votes cast, vote in
16 favor of the adoption of this act, it shall become effective 10
17 days following the certification of the election results.
