

HOUSE BILL No. 5080

October 6, 1993, Introduced by Reps. DeLange and Shugars and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend section 8 of chapter IV of Act No. 283 of the Public Acts of 1909, entitled as amended

"An act to revise, consolidate and add to the laws relating to the establishment, opening, discontinuing, vacating, closing, altering, improvement, maintenance and use of the public highways and private roads, the condemnation of property and gravel therefor; the building, repairing and preservation of bridges; setting and protecting shade trees, drainage, cutting weeds and brush within this state, and providing for the election or appointment and defining the powers, duties and compensation of state, county, township and district highway officials,"

being section 224.8 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 8 of chapter IV of Act No. 283 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1909, being section 224.8 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3 Laws, is amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER IV

- 2 Sec. 8. (1) In case IF a vacancy shall occur OCCURS in
- 3 the office of county road commissioner, the COUNTY board of
- 4 -supervisors COMMISSIONERS shall appoint a COUNTY ROAD commis-
- 5 sioner to fill -such THE vacancy. The COUNTY ROAD COM-
- 6 MISSIONER WHO IS APPOINTED shall hold office for the unexpired
- 7 portion of the term in which the vacancy occurs. Each COUNTY
- 8 ROAD commissioner shall hold $\frac{1}{2}$ office until his OR HER su c^-
- 9 cessor is elected or appointed and qualified.
- 10 (2) The COUNTY board of supervisors COMMISSIONERS shall
- 11 fix the compensation of -such- COUNTY ROAD commissioners.
- 12 (3) THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MAY AUTHORIZE THE PAR-
- 13 TICIPATION OF COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS IN AN INSURANCE OR
- 14 RETIREMENT PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 10A. ANY SUCH
- 15 AUTHORIZATION GRANTED BY A COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS BEFORE
- 16 THIS SUBSECTION WAS ADDED IS VALID. THE COST OF PARTICIPATION IN
- 17 THE INSURANCE OR RETIREMENT PROGRAM SHALL BE PAID BY THE COUNTY
- 18 ROAD COMMISSION FROM COUNTY ROAD FUNDS.
