



HOUSE BILL No. 5137

October 19, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Barns and referred to the Committee on Public Retirement.

A bill to amend section 24 of Act No. 240 of the Public Acts of 1943, entitled as amended
"State employees' retirement act,"
being section 38.24 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 24 of Act No. 240 of the Public Acts of 1943, being section 38.24 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 24. Subject to ~~the provisions of~~ sections 33 and 34, upon application of a member, ~~or his~~ THE MEMBER'S department head, or the state personnel director, a member who has ~~been a state employee at least~~ 10 OR MORE years OF CREDITED SERVICE, OR A MEMBER WHO MEETS THE SERVICE REQUIREMENTS FOR A DEFERRED RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER SECTION 20(4) OR (5) AND WHO becomes totally and permanently incapacitated for duty as the result of

 2 state, may be retired by the retirement board AS PROVIDED IN THIS
 3 SECTION. ~~Provided, The~~ IF THE medical advisor after a medi-
 4 cal examination of ~~such~~ THE member DETERMINES THAT THE MEMB^{ER}
 5 HAS BECOME TOTALLY AND PERMANENTLY INCAPACITATED FOR DUTY, TH^E
 6 MEDICAL ADVISOR shall certify that ~~such~~ THE member is menta^{lly}
 7 or physically incapacitated for the further performance of du^{ty},
 8 ~~and such~~ THAT THE incapacity is likely to be permanent, and
 9 that ~~such~~ THE member should be retired.
