A bill to amend section 3 of Act No 246 of the Public Acts of 1945 entitled as amended

An act to authorize township poards to adopt ordinances and equilations to secure the public health safety and general welfare to provide for the establishment of a township police department to provide for policing of townships by certain law enforcement officers and agencies to provide for the publication of ordinances to prescribe powers and duties of township boards and certain local and state officers and agencies to provide sanctions and to repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict with the act

- 25 (7) An action for the violation of a township ordinance
- 26 shall be instituted in the district court unless the person
- 27 alleged to have violated the ordinance admits responsibility at a

- 2 as otherwise provided and authorized by law Fines and costs
- 3 imposed or assessed in such an action shall be distributed in
- 4 accordance with section 8379 of THE REVISED JUDICATURE ACT OF
