

## **SENATE BILL No. 27**

January 13, 1993, Introduced by Senator EHLERS and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend section 310 of Act No. 300 of the Public

Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"Michigan vehicle code,"

as amended by Act No. 286 of the Public Acts of 1989, being section 257.310 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 310 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1949, as amended by Act No. 286 of the Public Acts of 1989, being
- 3 section 257.310 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
- 4 as follows:
- 5 Sec. 310. (1) The secretary of state shall issue AN
- 6 OPERATOR'S LICENSE to each person licensed as an operator, -an
- 7 operator's license, and A CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE to each person
- 8 licensed as a chauffeur. , a chauffeur's license. An applicant
- 9 for a motorcycle indorsement under section 312a or a vehicle

- 1 group designation or indorsement shall first qualify for an
- 2 operator's or chauffeur's license before the indorsement or vehi-
- 3 cle group designation application is accepted and processed.
- 4 (2) The license shall contain -the EACH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) THE distinguishing number permanently assigned to the
- 6 licensee. -and the-
- 7 (B) THE name, date of birth, address of residence, AND
- 8 height an OF THE LICENSEE.
- 9 (C) AN imprinted photograph -, and the OF THE LICENSEE.
- 10 (D) THE QUESTION "DO YOU WISH TO DONATE ORGANS AND TISSUE IN
- 11 THE EVENT OF YOUR DEATH?" ON THE FACE OF THE LICENSE, FOLLOWED
- 12 BY A BOX LABELED "YES" AND A BOX LABELED "NO".
- 13 (E) THE signature of the licensee FOLLOWING THE QUESTION
- 14 IDENTIFIED IN SUBDIVISION (D).
- 15 (3) BEFORE OR AT THE TIME A PERSON APPLIES FOR AN OPERATOR'S
- 16 OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DO THE
- 17 FOLLOWING:
- 18 (A) PROVIDE THE APPLICANT WITH A WRITTEN EXPLANATION OF THE
- 19 APPLICANT'S RIGHT TO MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT IN ACCORDANCE WITH
- 20 THIS SECTION.
- 21 (B) REQUIRE THE APPLICANT TO MARK THE "YES" OR "NO" BOX THAT
- 22 FOLLOWS THE QUESTION IDENTIFIED IN SUBSECTION (2) (D) BEFORE SIGN-
- 23 ING THE LICENSE APPLICATION.
- 24 (4) AT THE TIME A LICENSE IS ISSUED UNDER THIS ACT, THE SEC-
- 25 RETARY OF STATE SHALL PROVIDE THE LICENSEE WITH A STICKER THAT
- 26 THE LICENSEE MAY ATTACH TO THE REVERSE SIDE OF THE ISSUED
- 27 LICENSE, AND UPON WHICH THE LICENSEE MAY DESIGNATE ANY OF THE

- 1 FOLLOWING PURSUANT TO PART 101 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, ACT NO.
- 2 368 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTIONS 333.10101 TO
- 3 333.10109 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS:
- 4 (A) EACH LIMITATION, IF ANY, HE OR SHE IMPOSES UPON A DONA-
- 5 TION OR GIFT OF ORGANS AND TISSUE MADE UPON THE FACE OF THE
- 6 LICENSE.
- 7 (B) ADDITIONAL ANATOMICAL GIFTS OR DONATIONS HE OR SHE IS
- 8 MAKING, INCLUDING THE GIFT OR DONATION OF HIS OR HER ENTIRE
- 9 BODY.
- 10 (C) THE RESCISSION OF A GIFT DESIGNATION APPEARING UPON THE
- 11 FACE OF THE LICENSE, OR THE ELECTION TO MAKE A GIFT THAT DOES NOT
- 12 APPEAR ON THE FACE OF THE LICENSE.
- 13 (5) A LICENSEE SHALL NOT ATTACH A STICKER DESCRIBED IN SUB-
- 14 SECTION (4) TO HIS OR HER LICENSE UNLESS HE OR SHE HAS COMPLETED
- 15 AND SIGNED THE STICKER. A TERM ON A STICKER THAT IS INCONSISTENT
- 16 WITH A TERM ON THE FACE OF A LICENSE ISSUED TO THAT PERSON UNDER
- 17 THIS ACT SUPERSEDES THE INCONSISTENT TERM APPEARING ON THE FACE
- 18 OF THE LICENSE.
- (6) The license shall be manufactured in a manner to pro-
- 20 hibit as nearly as possible the ability to reproduce, alter,
- 21 counterfeit, forge, or duplicate the license without ready
- 22 detection. In addition, a license with a vehicle group designa-
- 23 tion shall contain the information required pursuant to
- 24 49 C.F.R. part 383.
- 25 (7) -(3) A person who intentionally reproduces, alters,
- 26 counterfeits, forges, or duplicates a license photograph, the
- 27 negative of the photograph, a license, or a part of a license, or

- 1 who uses a license or photograph that has been reproduced,
- 2 altered, counterfeited, forged, or duplicated shall be punished
- 3 as follows:
- 4 (a) If the intent of the reproduction, alteration, counter-
- 5 feiting, forging, duplication, or use was to commit or aid in the
- 6 commission of an offense punishable by imprisonment for 1 or more
- 7 years, the person committing the reproduction, alteration, coun-
- 8 terfeiting, forging, duplication, or use is guilty of a misde-
- 9 meanor, punishable by imprisonment for a period equal to that
- 10 which could be imposed for the commission of the offense the
- 11 person had the intent to aid or commit. The court may also
- 12 assess a fine of not more than \$10,000.00 against the person.
- 13 (b) If the intent of the reproduction, alteration, counter-
- 14 feiting, forging, duplication, or use was to commit or aid in the
- 15 commission of an offense punishable by imprisonment for not more
- 16 than 1 year, the person committing the reproduction, alteration,
- 17 counterfeiting, forging, duplication, or use is guilty of a mis-
- 18 demeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year, or
- 19 a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 20 (8) <del>(4) The secretary of state,</del> BEFORE ISSUING AN
- 21 OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE TO AN APPLICANT, AND upon
- 22 determining after an examination that -an THE applicant is men-
- 23 tally and physically qualified to receive a license, THE
- 24 SECRETARY OF STATE may issue to that person a temporary
- 25 driver's permit entitling the person while having the permit in
- 26 his or her immediate possession THE APPLICANT to drive a motor
- 27 vehicle upon the highway, WHILE THAT APPLICANT HAS THE PERMIT IN

- 1 HIS OR HER IMMEDIATE POSSESSION, for a period not exceeding 60
- 2 days. before issuance to the person of an operator's or
- 3 chauffeur's license by the secretary of state.
- 4 (9) -(5) An operator or chauffeur may place on the reverse
- 5 side of a license his or her blood type, immunization data, medi-
- 6 cation data, OR a statement that the licensee is deaf. or a
- 7 statement that the licensee has made an anatomical gift pursuant
- 8 to part 101 of the public health code, Act No. 368 of the Public
- 9 Acts of 1978, being sections 333.10101 to 333.10109 of the
- 10 Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 11 (10) -(6) The phrase "See reverse side for medical data" -
- 12 or anatomical gift" followed by a box shall be printed on the
- 13 front of the license. If the licensee places on the reverse side
- 14 of the license any of the information described in subsection
- 15 -(5) (9), an "X" shall be inserted in the box.
- 16 (11) -(7)— If the applicant provides proof to the secretary
- 17 of state that he or she is a minor who has been emancipated pur-
- 18 suant to Act No. 293 of the Public Acts of 1968, being sections
- 19 722.1 to 722.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, THE REVERSE SIDE OF
- 20 the license on the reverse side ISSUED TO THAT APPLICANT shall
- 21 bear the designation of the individual's emancipated status.
- 22 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 23 all of the following bills of the 87th Legislature are enacted
- 24 into law:
