



SENATE BILL No. 197

January 26, 1993, Introduced by Senators PRIDNIA, WELBORN, BOUCHARD, ARTHURHULTZ, EMMONS, GEAKE and DI NELLO and referred to the Committee on Family Law, Criminal Law, and Corrections.

A bill to amend Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended
"Public health code,"
as amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 7407a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as
2 amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 7407a to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 7407A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT ATTEMPT TO VIOLATE THIS
6 PART.

7 (2) A PERSON SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY OR INTENTIONALLY SOLICIT,
8 INDUCE, OR INTIMIDATE ANOTHER PERSON TO VIOLATE THIS PART.

1 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A CRIME
2 PUNISHABLE BY THE PENALTY FOR THE CRIME HE OR SHE ATTEMPTED TO
3 COMMIT, OR BY THE PENALTY FOR THE CRIME HE OR SHE SOLICITED,
4 INDUCED, OR INTIMIDATED ANOTHER PERSON TO COMMIT.
