



SENATE BILL No. 280

January 28, 1993, Introduced by Senator BOUCHARD and referred to the Committee on Family Law, Criminal Law, and Corrections.

A bill to amend section 606 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended "Revised judicature act of 1961," as added by Act No. 52 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 600.606 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 606 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of
2 1961, as added by Act No. 52 of the Public Acts of 1988, being
3 section 600.606 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 606. The circuit court ~~shall have~~ HAS jurisdiction
6 to hear and determine a violation of section 83, 89, 91, 316,
7 317, 520b, or 529 of the Michigan penal code, Act No. 328 of the
8 Public Acts of 1931, being sections 750.83, 750.89, 750.91,
9 750.316, 750.317, 750.520b, and 750.529 of the Michigan Compiled

1 Laws; ~~—or—~~ section 7401(2)(a)(i) or 7403(2)(a)(i) of the public
2 health code, Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sec-
3 tions 333.7401 and 333.7403 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; OR
4 ANOTHER LAW OF THIS STATE, THE VIOLATION OF WHICH MAY BE PUNISHED
5 BY LIFE IMPRISONMENT, if committed by a juvenile ~~—15—~~ 14 years of
6 age or older and less than 17 years of age.

7 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
