

SENATE BILL No. 508

March 17, 1993, Introduced by Senators GAST, EHLERS, SCHWARZ, ARTHURHULTZ, CISKY, GEAKE, EMMONS, FAUST, BERRYMAN, MC MANUS, VAUGHN, CONROY, DE GROW, KOIVISTO, POLLACK, DINGELL, HART, PRIDNIA, DUNASKISS and WARTNER and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations to the department of natural resources to provide for the acquisition of land; to provide for the development of public recreation facilities; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to provide for the expenditure of appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. There is appropriated for the department of natural
- 2 resources to supplement former appropriations for the fiscal year ending
- 3 September 30, 1993, the sum of \$15,819,250.00 for land acquisition and
- grants and \$4,455,850.00 for public recreation facility development and
- 5 grants as provided in section 35 of article IX of the state constitution
- 6 of 1963 and the Michigan natural resources trust fund act, Act No. 101 of
- 7 the Public Acts of 1985, being sections 318.501 to 318.516 of the
- 8 Michigan Compiled Laws, from the following funds:

25	Sec. 3. The department of natural resources shall enter into agree-
26	ments with local units of government for the purpose of administering the
27	grants identified in section 1. Among other provisions, the agreements

- 1 shall require that grant recipients agree to dedicate to public
- 2 recreation uses in perpetuity the land acquired; to replace lands con-
- 3 verted or lost to other than public recreation use; and to convey to the
- 4 state any mineral interests acquired by the grant recipient with an
- 5 exception allowed for a share of the mineral interests acquired, which
- 6 share is based on the portion of the fair market value of the property
- 7 that was provided by the local cash contribution of the grant recipient.
- 8 The agreements shall also provide that full payments of grants be made
- 9 only after proof of acquisition is submitted by the grant recipient and
- 10 all costs are verified by the department of natural resources.
- 11 Sec. 4. The department of natural resources shall take steps neces-
- 12 sary to make available federal or other funds that may become available
- 13 for the purpose for which appropriations are made in section 1, and to
- 14 use any or all of the appropriations to meet matching requirements which
- 15 are determined to be in the best interest of the state.
- 16 Sec. 5. Any unobligated balance in any appropriation made under
- 17 section 1 shall not revert to the fund from which appropriated at the
- 18 close of the fiscal year, but shall continue until the purpose for which
- 19 it was appropriated is completed. The unexpended balance of any appro-
- 20 priation made in section 1 remaining after the purpose for which it was
- 21 appropriated is completed shall revert to the Michigan natural resources
- 22 trust fund and be made available for appropriation.
- 23 Sec. 6. If a person or organization has acquired an option on a
- 24 parcel of property prior to final determination by the department of nat-
- 25 ural resources and the Michigan natural resources trust fund board, the
- 26 property shall not be considered for acquisition unless the department
- 27 and board can demonstrate that a clear recreational advantage exists in

- 1 obtaining the parcel of property for the people of the state at a
- 2 reasonable fair market value.
- 3 Sec. 7. As required by section 4(3) of the Michigan natural
- 4 resources trust fund act, Act No. 101 of the Public Acts of 1985, being
- 5 section 318.504 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, the grants-in-aid to local
- 6 units of government shall be awarded pursuant to this act.
- 7 Sec. 8. The appropriation in section 1 (Priority No. 4) for various
- 8 water access sites land acquisition (#92-334) shall not be expended for
- 9 land acquisition on a lake not specifically identified.
