

## SENATE BILL No. 788

August 3, 1993, Introduced by Senators HOFFMAN, DINGELL, DUNASKISS and EHLERS and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend sections 1, 2, and 3 of Act No. 269 of the Public Acts of 1989, entitled

"An act to provide civil immunity to persons who operate or use certain sport shooting ranges; and to regulate the application of state and local laws, rules, regulations, and ordinances regarding sport shooting ranges,"

being sections 691.1541, 691.1542, and 691.1543 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 2a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 1, 2, and 3 of Act No. 269 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1989, being sections 691.1541, 691.1542, and
- 3 691.1543 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended and
- 4 section 2a is added to read as follows:
- Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 6 (A) "GENERALLY ACCEPTED MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION PRACTICES"
- 7 MEANS THOSE PRACTICES DEFINED BY A NONPROFIT MEMBERSHIP

- 1 ORGANIZATION THAT PROVIDES VOLUNTARY PISTOL SAFETY PROGRAMS THAT
- 2 INCLUDE TRAINING INDIVIDUALS IN THE SAFE HANDLING AND USE OF PIS-
- 3 TOLS, WHICH PRACTICES CONSIDER ALL INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO IT
- 4 REGARDING THE OPERATION OF SHOOTING RANGES.
- 5 (B) -(a) "Local unit of government" means a county, city,
- 6 township, or village.
- 7 (C) -(b) "Person" means an individual, proprietorship,
- 8 partnership, corporation, club, or other legal entity.
- 9 (D) (S) "Sport shooting range" or "range" means an area
- 10 designed and operated for the use of ARCHERY, rifles, shotguns,
- 11 pistols, silhouettes, skeet, trap, black powder, or any other
- 12 similar sport shooting.
- Sec. 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, AND
- 14 IN ADDITION TO OTHER PROTECTIONS PROVIDED IN THIS ACT, a person
- 15 who operates or uses a sport shooting range in this state -shall-
- 16 IS not -be subject to civil liability or criminal prosecution in
- 17 any matter relating to noise or noise pollution resulting from
- 18 the operation or use of the range if the range is in compliance
- 19 with any noise control laws or ordinances that applied to the
- 20 range and its operation at the time construction or operation of
- 21 the range was approved by a local unit of government.
- 22 (2) A IN ADDITION TO OTHER PROTECTIONS PROVIDED IN THIS
- 23 ACT, A person who operates or uses a sport shooting range is not
- 24 subject to an action for nuisance, and a court of the state shall
- 25 not enjoin the use or operation of a range on the basis of noise
- 26 or noise pollution, if the range is in compliance with any noise
- 27 control laws or ordinances that applied to the range and its

- 1 operation at the time construction or operation of the range was
- 2 approved by a local unit of government.
- 3 (3) Rules or regulations adopted by any state department or
- 4 agency for limiting levels of noise in terms of decibel level
- 5 which may occur in the outdoor atmosphere -shall DO not apply to
- 6 a sport shooting range exempted from liability under this act.
- 7 SEC. 2A. (1) A SPORT SHOOTING RANGE IS NOT A PUBLIC OR PRI-
- 8 VATE NUISANCE IF THE SPORT SHOOTING RANGE ALLEGED TO BE A NUI-
- 9 SANCE CONFORMS TO GENERALLY ACCEPTED MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION
- 10 PRACTICES.
- 11 (2) A SPORT SHOOTING RANGE IS NOT A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE NUI-
- 12 SANCE IF THE SPORT SHOOTING RANGE EXISTED BEFORE A CHANGE IN THE
- 13 LAND USE OR OCCUPANCY OF LAND WITHIN 1 MILE OF THE BOUNDARIES OF
- 14 THE SPORT SHOOTING RANGE, AND IF BEFORE THAT CHANGE IN LAND USE
- 15 OR OCCUPANCY OF LAND, THE SPORT SHOOTING RANGE WOULD NOT HAVE
- 16 BEEN A NUISANCE. THIS EXEMPTION APPLIES TO A SPORT SHOOTING
- 17 RANGE THAT EXPANDS OR INCREASES THE EVENTS OR ACTIVITIES IT
- 18 OFFERS OR EXPANDS OR INCREASES ITS MEMBERSHIP OR OPPORTUNITIES
- 19 FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION, OR DOES BOTH.
- 20 Sec. 3. This act does not -prohibit DO EITHER OF THE
- 21 FOLLOWING:
- 22 (A) PROHIBIT a local unit of government from regulating the
- 23 location, use, operation, safety, and construction of a sport
- 24 shooting range after the effective date of this act
- 25 DECEMBER 26, 1989 IN A MANNER THAT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE
- 26 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ACT.

- 1 (B) AFFECT THE APPLICATION OF OTHER APPLICABLE STATE AND
- 2 FEDERAL STATUTES.
