

SENATE BILL No. 840

September 21, 1993, Introduced by Senator VAN REGENMORTER and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 8301 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
being section 600.8301 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 8301 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1961, being section 600.8301 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 8301. (1) The district court shall have HAS exclu-
- 5 sive jurisdiction in civil actions when the amount in controversy
- 6 does not exceed \$10,000.00. THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) UNTIL JANUARY 1, 1994, \$10,000.00.
- 8 (B) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1994, \$25,000.00.
- 9 (2) The district court -shall have HAS jurisdiction over
- 10 civil infraction actions.
