



SENATE BILL No. 1026

February 17, 1994, Introduced by Senator FAUST and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs

A bill to amend Act No 17 of the Public Acts of 1921, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the protection and conservation of the natural resources of the state to provide and develop facilities for outdoor recreation to create a conservation department to define the powers and duties thereof to provide rules and regulations concerning the use and occupancy of lands and property under its control and penalties for the violation thereof to provide for the transfer to said department of the powers and duties now vested by law in certain boards, commissions and officers of the state and for the abolishing of the boards commissions and offices the powers and duties of which are hereby transferred "

as amended, being sections 299 1 to 299 10 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 4a

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- 1 Section 1 Act No 17 of the Public Acts of 1921, as
- 2 amended, being sections 299 1 to 299 10 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3 Laws, is amended by adding section 4a to read as follows

1 SEC 4A UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW, IF THE
2 DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES PUBLISHES A PUBLIC NOTICE ON A
3 PERMIT APPLICATION SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT, THE DEPARTMENT
4 SHALL PUBLISH THAT PUBLIC NOTICE IN THE SAME NEWSPAPER THAT IS
5 USED TO PUBLISH LEGAL NOTICES BY THE CITY VILLAGE OR TOWNSHIP
6 IN WHICH THE PROPOSED PROJECT IS LOCATED
