

## **SENATE BILL No. 1076**

March 24, 1994, Introduced by Senators DINGELL and WELBORN and referred to the Committee on Family Law, Mental Health, and Corrections

A bill to establish an assault weapons commission to prescribe its powers and duties to provide for the appointment of its members and to provide for its dissolution

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- 1 Sec 1 This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "assault weapons commission act"
- 3 Sec 2 As used in this act
- 4 (a) "Commission" means the assault weapons commission cre-
- 5 ated in section 3
- 6 (b) "Department" means the department of state
- 7 Sec 3 The assault weapons commission is created within
- 8 the department The commission is an autonomous entity and shall
- 9 exercise its powers and perform its duties independently of the
- 10 department, except for budgeting, procurement, and related
- 11 management functions

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- 1 Sec 4 The commission shall be composed of the following
- 2 members
- 3 (a) Two members representative of an organization that
- 4 opposes the strict regulation of the possession of firearms 1 of
- 5 whom shall be appointed by the majority leader of the senate and
- 6 1 of whom shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of
- 7 representatives
- 8 (b) Two members representative of an organization that sup-
- 9 ports strict regulation of firearms, 1 of whom shall be appointed
- 10 by the majority leader of the senate and 1 of whom shall be
- 11 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives
- (c) Two persons not representative of an organization
- 13 described in subdivision (a) or (b) appointed by the majority
- 14 leader of the senate
- 15 (d) Two persons not representative of an organization
- 16 described in subdivision (a) or (b) appointed by the speaker of
- 17 the house of representatives
- (e) Two members representative of a state law enforcement
- 19 agency or agencies, appointed by the governor
- 20 (f) One member of the public appointed by the governor
- 21 Sec 5 (1) The governor shall appoint a member of the com-
- 22 mission to be chairperson of the commission
- 23 (2) A vacancy on the commission shall be filled in the same
- 24 manner as the original appointment
- 25 (3) The governor may remove a member of the commission from
- 26 office in accordance with section 10 of article V of the state
- 27 constitution of 1963 Each appointed member of the commission

- 1 shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for all
- 2 necessary travel and other expenses incurred in performing com-
- 3 mission duties
- 4 Sec 6 The commission shall do each of the following
- 5 (a) Meet upon the call of the chairperson
- 6 (b) Hold hearings at times and at places the commission
- 7 designates
- 8 (c) Hold its meetings pursuant to the open meetings act, Act
- 9 No 267 of the Public Acts of 1976, being sections 15 261 to
- 10 15 275 of the Michigan Compiled Laws
- 11 (d) Make recommendations to reduce or prevent the unlawful
- 12 use of assault weapons within the state
- (e) Upon request, disclose to the public information
- 14 obtained by the commission pursuant to this act that is not
- 15 exempt from public disclosure under the freedom of information
- 16 act, Act No 442 of the Public Acts of 1976 being sections
- 17 15 231 to 15 246 of the Michigan Compiled Laws
- 18 (f) Within 1 year after the effective date of this act,
- 19 submit a report to the governor the majority leader of the
- 20 senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the leg-
- 21 islature that identifies the specific types of weapons and fire-
- 22 arms being used in the commission of crime within the state
- Sec 7 The commission is dissolved upon submitting the
- 24 report required under subdivision (f), or upon the expiration of
- 25 1 year after the effective date of this act, whichever occurs
- 26 first

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
