



SENATE BILL No. 1147

A bill to amend Act No 17 of the Public Acts of 1921, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the protection and conservation of the natural resources of the state to provide and develop facilities for outdoor recreation to create a conservation department to define the powers and duties thereof to provide rules and regulations concerning the use and occupancy of lands and property under its control and penalties for the violation thereof to provide for the transfer to said department of the powers and duties now vested by law in certain boards, commissions and officers of the state and for the abolishing of the boards commissions and offices the powers and duties of which are hereby transferred,"

as amended being sections 299 1 to 299 10 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws by adding section 3c

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Act No 17 of the Public Acts of 1921, as
2 amended, being sections 299 1 to 299 10 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 3c to read as follows

1 SEC 3C WHEN THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES CONDUCTS
2 A HUMAN HEALTH RISK ASSESSMENT THAT INVOLVES A SUBSTANCE KNOWN OR
3 SUSPECTED TO BE TOXIC TO HUMAN REPRODUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT, THE
4 DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE IN ITS ASSESSMENT THE POTENTIAL FOR
5 ADVERSE HUMAN REPRODUCTIVE AND DEVELOPMENTAL EFFECTS INCLUDING,
6 BUT NOT LIMITED TO IMPAIRMENTS TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF REPRODUC-
7 TIVE ENDOCRINE, IMMUNE, AND NERVOUS SYSTEM FUNCTIONS IN ALL
8 STAGES OF HUMAN DEVELOPMENT, BOTH BEFORE AND AFTER BIRTH, DUE TO
9 EXPOSURE TO THE SUBSTANCES IN ADDITION THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
10 ESTABLISH AND AMEND DEPARTMENTAL STANDARDS AS NECESSARY TO
11 REFLECT CONSIDERATION OF ADVERSE HUMAN REPRODUCTION OR DEVELOP-
12 MENTAL EFFECTS
