



# SENATE BILL No. 1269

September 21, 1994, Introduced by Senators MC MANUS,  
KOIVISTO and PRIDNIA and referred to the Committee  
on Transportation and Tourism

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No 319 of the Public Acts  
of 1975, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the titling, licensure, and regulation of  
off-road recreation vehicles to create certain funds to create  
certain advisory bodies and to prescribe their powers and duties  
to prescribe powers and duties of certain officers, agencies, and  
institutions to provide certain tort immunity for certain gov-  
ernmental agencies under certain circumstances to repeal certain  
parts of this act on a specific date and to provide penalties  
and remedies,"

as amended by Act No 71 of the Public Acts of 1990, being sec-  
tion 257 1602 of the Michigan Compiled Laws

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Section 2 of Act No 319 of the Public Acts of  
2 1975, as amended by Act No 71 of the Public Acts of 1990, being  
3 section 257 1602 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to  
4 read as follows

1       Sec 2   (1) A vehicle registered under the code, or a  
2 vehicle registered under THE MARINE SAFETY ACT, Act No 303 of  
3 the Public Acts of 1967, as amended, being sections 281 1001 to  
4 281 1199 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is exempt from the licen-  
5 sure provisions of this act, unless the vehicle is operated as an  
6 ORV off highways, roadways, streets, and forest roads

7       (2) AN ORV OPERATED SOLELY ON PRIVATE PROPERTY BY THE OWNER  
8 OF THE PROPERTY, A FAMILY MEMBER OF THE OWNER, OR AN INVITED  
9 GUEST OF THE OWNER IS EXEMPT FROM THE LICENSURE PROVISIONS OF  
10 THIS ACT
