



HOUSE BILL No. 4606

March 16, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Brackenridge and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend sections 261 and 264 of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1954, entitled as amended "Michigan election law," being sections 168.261 and 168.264 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Sections 261 and 264 of Act No. 116 of the
2 Public Acts of 1954, being sections 168.261 and 168.264 of the
3 Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 261. ~~A county~~ COUNTY road ~~commissioner~~
5 COMMISSIONERS shall be elected at the general NOVEMBER election.
6 ~~to be held on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday of~~
7 ~~November in every even numbered year.~~

8 Sec. 264. The term of office for county road ~~commissioner~~
9 shall be COMMISSIONERS ELECTED BEFORE THE 1996 GENERAL NOVEMBER

1 ELECTION IS 6 years. ~~, beginning~~ THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR COUNTY
2 ROAD COMMISSIONERS ELECTED AT OR AFTER THE 1996 GENERAL NOVEMBER
3 ELECTION IS 4 YEARS, EXCEPT THAT THE TERM OF OFFICE OF 1 OF THE
4 COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS ELECTED AT THE 1996 GENERAL NOVEMBER
5 ELECTION IS 2 YEARS. THE TERM OF OFFICE OF A COUNTY ROAD COMMIS-
6 SIONER SHALL BEGIN on the first day of January ~~next~~ following
7 his OR HER election, and shall continue until a successor ~~shall~~
8 ~~have been~~ IS elected and qualified.

9 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
10 Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 4607 (request
11 no. 01904'95) of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
