A bill to amend 1978 PA 642, entitled "Revised probate code," by amending section 103 (MCL 700.103).

- 26 (C) "MEDICAL RECORDS" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO,
- 27 MEDICAL HISTORIES, MEDICAL REPORTS, MEDICAL SUMMARIES, MEDICAL
