

**SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 4780**

A bill to amend 1974 PA 154, entitled
"Michigan occupational safety and health act,"
(MCL 408.1001 to 408.1094) by adding section 24b; and to repeal
acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 24B. (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AND INDUSTRY SERV-
2 ICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL JOINTLY CONDUCT
3 A STUDY OF PRACTICES AND PROCEDURES IN THE HEALTH CARE WORKPLACE
4 RELATED TO NEEDLE SAFETY.

5 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AND INDUSTRY SERVICES SHALL
6 PROVIDE TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES TO EMPLOYERS ON NEEDLE SAFETY IN
7 THE HEALTH CARE WORKPLACE THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT'S SAFETY EDUCA-
8 TION TRAINING PROGRAM.

1 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

2 (A) "HEALTH CARE WORKPLACE" MEANS HEALTH FACILITIES LICENSED
3 UNDER ARTICLE 17 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL
4 333.20101 TO 333.22260, OR ANY OTHER FACILITIES IN WHICH HEALTH
5 CARE SERVICES ARE PROVIDED.

6 (B) "NEEDLE" MEANS A HYPODERMIC SYRINGE OR OTHER DEVICE USED
7 TO WITHDRAW BODY FLUIDS, ACCESS A VEIN OR ARTERY, OR ADMINISTER
8 MEDICATIONS OR OTHER FLUIDS.

9 (4) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED EFFECTIVE UPON THE EXPIRATION
10 OF 2 YEARS AFTER THE DATE THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SEC-
11 TION IS ENACTED.

12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
13 effect unless House Bill No. 4621 of the 90th Legislature is
14 enacted into law.
