A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled
"General sales tax act,"
(MCL 205.51 to 205.78) by adding section 4x.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 4X. (1) A PERSON SUBJECT TO THE TAX UNDER THIS ACT MAY
2 EXCLUDE FROM THE GROSS PROCEEDS USED FOR THE COMPUTATION OF THE
3 TAX THE SALE TO A HOSPITAL OF EQUIPMENT FOR USE IN PERFORMING
4 ORGAN DONOR TRANSPLANTS AT THAT HOSPITAL.

5 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "HOSPITAL" MEANS THAT TERM AS
6 DEFINED IN SECTION 20106 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368,
7 MCL 333.20106.
