



# HOUSE BILL No. 4994

October 13, 1999, Introduced by Rep. Kukuk and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code," by amending section 215 (MCL 750.215), as amended by 1991 PA 145.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 215. ~~Any~~ A person who falsely assumes or pretends to  
2 be a sheriff, deputy sheriff, conservation officer, coroner, con-  
3 stable, police officer, INVESTIGATOR OR INSPECTOR OF THE MICHIGAN  
4 LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION, or member of the Michigan state  
5 police, and shall take upon himself or herself to act as such, or  
6 to require any person to aid and assist him or her in any matter  
7 pertaining to the duty of a sheriff, deputy sheriff, conservation  
8 officer, coroner, constable, police officer, INVESTIGATOR OR  
9 INSPECTOR OF THE MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION, or member of  
10 the Michigan state police, or shall falsely take upon himself or

1 herself to act or officiate in any office or place of authority,  
2 ~~shall be~~ IS guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment  
3 for not more than 1 year, or by fine of not more than \$500.00.
