SUMMARY

House Bills 6108 through 6113 would amend Public Act 372 of 1927 and the Michigan Penal Code to provide exemptions from certain requirements concerning concealed weapon licensure for former police officers, reserve police officers, and part-time police officers. The bills would have no direct fiscal impact on state or local government.
