SUMMARY

HB 6293 would amend the Social Welfare Act (P.A. 280 of 1939) allowing the Director of the Family Independence Agency with the consent of the respective counties, to develop a collaborative reporting relationship between two or more counties. This plan would supercede present law which permits the Director to organize two counties into a single administrative unit.

HB 6293 could potentially result in administrative savings for the department due to the fact that more than two counties would be allowed to merge. However, the indeterminate savings would not be significant.
