- 3 erty to an apparent extent totaling \$\frac{\$400.00}{}\$1,000.00 or more,
- 4 shall immediately report that accident at the nearest or most
- 5 convenient police station, or to the nearest or most convenient
- 6 police officer. The officer receiving the report, or his or her
- 7 commanding officer, shall immediately forward each report to the
- 8 director of THE DEPARTMENT OF state police on forms prescribed by
- 9 the director of THE DEPARTMENT OF state police. The forms shall

- 1 of THE DEPARTMENT OF state police shall analyze each report
- 2 relative to the cause of the reported accident and shall prepare
- 3 information compiled from reports filed under this section for

- 6 least 3 years at the local police department, sheriff's depart-
- 7 ment, or local state police post making the report.
