

HB6202, As Passed House, June 27, 2002

**SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 6202**

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 722.111 to 722.128) by adding section 9.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 9. (1) A STAFF MEMBER SHALL NOT BE PRESENT IN A CHILD
2 CARE CENTER IF HE OR SHE HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF EITHER OF THE
3 FOLLOWING:

4 (A) CHILD ABUSE OR CHILD NEGLECT.

5 (B) A FELONY INVOLVING HARM OR THREATENED HARM TO AN INDI-
6 VIDUAL WITHIN THE 10 YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF
7 HIRE.

1 (2) A VOLUNTEER WHO IS NOT A PARENT, GRANDPARENT, OR LEGAL
2 GUARDIAN OF A CHILD RECEIVING CARE AT THE CHILD CARE CENTER SHALL
3 NOT HAVE CONTACT WITH CHILDREN WHO ARE IN THE CARE OF THAT CHILD
4 CARE CENTER IF HE OR SHE HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF EITHER OF THE
5 FOLLOWING:

6 (A) CHILD ABUSE OR CHILD NEGLECT.

7 (B) A FELONY INVOLVING HARM OR THREATENED HARM TO AN INDI-
8 VIDUAL WITHIN THE 10 YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF
9 OFFERING TO VOLUNTEER AT THE CHILD CARE CENTER.

10 (3) BEFORE A STAFF MEMBER OR VOLUNTEER WHO IS NOT A PARENT,
11 GRANDPARENT, OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF A CHILD RECEIVING CARE AT THE
12 CHILD CARE CENTER MAY HAVE CONTACT WITH A CHILD WHO IS IN THE
13 CARE OF A CHILD CARE CENTER, THE STAFF MEMBER OR VOLUNTEER SHALL
14 PROVIDE THE CHILD CARE CENTER WITH DOCUMENTATION FROM THE FAMILY
15 INDEPENDENCE AGENCY THAT HE OR SHE HAS NOT BEEN NAMED IN A CEN-
16 TRAL REGISTRY CASE AS THE PERPETRATOR OF CHILD ABUSE OR CHILD
17 NEGLECT. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "CHILD ABUSE" AND "CHILD
18 NEGLECT" MEAN THOSE TERMS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE CHILD
19 PROTECTION LAW, 1975 PA 238, MCL 722.622.

20 (4) EACH CHILD CARE CENTER SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A
21 POLICY REGARDING SUPERVISION OF VOLUNTEERS INCLUDING VOLUNTEERS
22 WHO ARE PARENTS OF A CHILD RECEIVING CARE AT THE CHILD CARE
23 CENTER.
