REPORT WITH AN AGENCY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, the bank shall

also within 24 hours file a copy of the <u>transaction</u> SUSPICIOUS

ACTIVITY report with the department of state police.

(2) THE BANK MAY FILE THE SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY REPORT AS

REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IN ANY MANNER THAT IS ALLOWED BY

FEDERAL LAW OR REGULATION [OR ANY MANNER THAT IS ACCEPTABLE TO THE STATE POLICE].
