

HOUSE BILL No. 5917

April 16, 2002, Introduced by Rep. Tabor and referred to the Committee on Employment Relations, Training and Safety.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 303, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan work-study program for qualified resident students attending eligible graduate and professional graduate schools and employed by qualified employers; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies; and to provide for an appropriation,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 390.1323).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 3. A recognized graduate or professional graduate
2 school in this state is eligible to participate in the program if
3 the graduate or professional graduate school is a degree-granting
4 institution approved by the ~~state board of education~~ DEPARTMENT
5 OF CAREER DEVELOPMENT, the instructional programs are not com-
6 prised solely of sectarian instruction or religious worship, and
7 the school participates in the federal work-study program under
8 sections 441 to 448 of title IV of the higher education act of
9 1965, 42 U.S.C. 2751 to 2756b. A participating school, at its

1 option, may offer academic credit to students enrolled in the
2 program.
