

SENATE BILL No. 186

February 8, 2001, Introduced by Senator JAYE and referred to the Committee on Gaming and Casino Oversight.

A bill to amend the Initiated Law of 1996, entitled "Michigan gaming control and revenue act," (MCL 432.201 to 432.226) by adding section 11a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 11A. (1) A CASINO LICENSEE SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD EACH
2 TIME A PERSON WINS \$1,000.00 OR MORE AT THE LICENSEE'S CASINO.

3 (2) THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL INCLUDE
4 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

5 (A) THE NAME, ADDRESS, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, AND BIRTH
6 DATE OF THE PERSON.

7 (B) THE AMOUNT OF MONEY WON BY THE PERSON.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
9 effect unless Senate Bill No. 187

10 of the 91st Legislature is enacted into
11 law.
