Analysis

Summary

This bill would amend the public health code to require the Departments of Community Health and Environmental Quality to identify pollutants accessible to children that are suspected health risks. The bill requires the distribution of this information to parents with advise on how to protect children from exposure to identified pollution risks.

Fiscal Impact

There would be an indeterminate impact on the Department of Community Health, depending on the amount and frequency of the publication of information required by this bill. There would be no fiscal impact on local governmental units.
